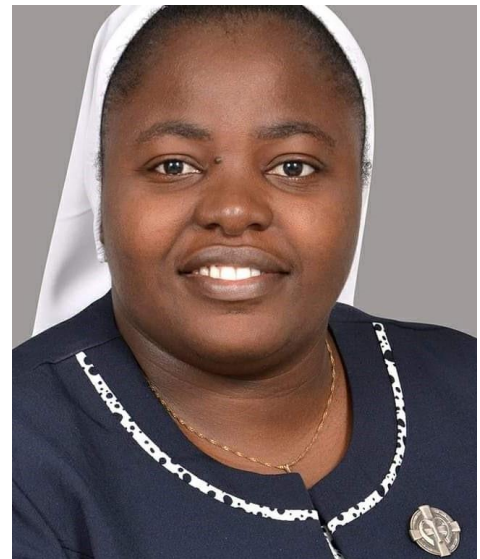

OBITUARY ANNOUNCEMENT OF SISTER GLORIA JACINTA OCHU ADOGA, SSND
